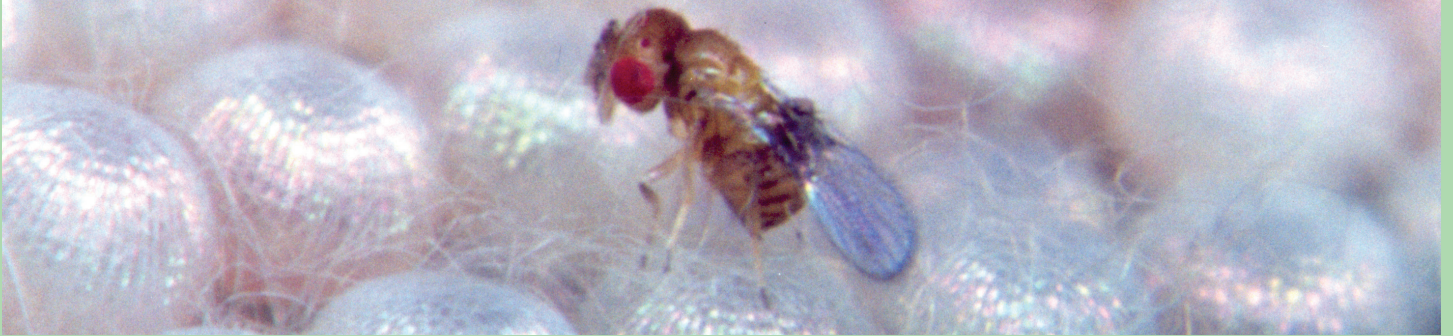


Pretiobug



Trichogramma pretiosum is a parasitic wasp targeting eggs of most moths and butterflies

Target the eggs of:



Bollworm
(*Helicoverpa armigera* and others)



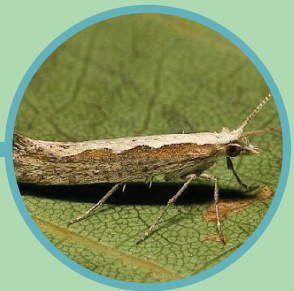
Tuta
(*Tuta absoluta*)



Fall Armyworm
(*Spodoptera frugiperda*)



Codling moth
(*Cydia pomonella*)



Diamondback Moth
(*Plutella xylostella*)

Used in fruits, vegetables, flowers, cannabis, propagation and many other crops.

Application instructions:

- Apply 100,000 pupae per hectare per release
- Apply as often as necessary or on fixed schedule during critical phases.
- Apply directly in field by cards or loose material.
- Apply in shade or under canopy.

Transport and storage



Tips:

- Should be used as part of IPM program
- Should be used preventative
- Schedule application by monitoring or critical phase of crop or season
- Ensure good ant control in field
